Subject : Information about call-off of strike at Arvind Limited

Dear Sirs,

Further to our intimation dated June 5, 2012 and June 18, 2012, we have to inform that the workers of our Naroda Denim Plant and Ankur Textiles (a division of Arvind Limited) have called-off the strike unconditionally and have resumed the work from third shift on Friday, June 29, 2012.

It may be recalled that the workers' strike started with about 200 workers of Naroda Denim Plant abstaining from work from 4th June 2012. There after other workers also joined the strike. The Naroda plant employs about 3400 workers. As a result, operation of the plant has been affected. Half of 1100 workers of Ankur Textiles (a division of Arvind Limited) had also joined the strike on June 17, 2012 thereby partially affecting the operations.

Arvind and its workers have reached to an agreement to call-off the strike unconditionally and accordingly the workers have resumed the work from third shift on Friday, June 29, 2012.

The Naroda Denim plant primarily makes denim fabrics and has annual capacity of about 90 Million meters out of 108 Million meters of total denim capacity of the company. We expect that the production of Naroda Denim Plant as well as Ankur Textile will reach to the normal level in about week's time.

We request you to bring the above fact to the notice of all concerned.
